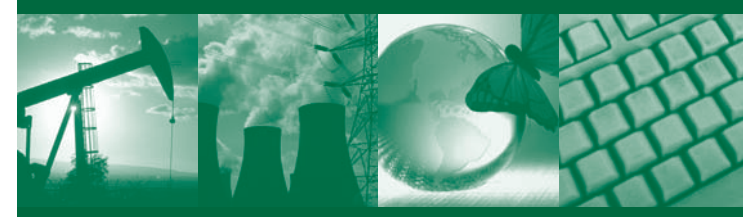

HAZWOPER Training Courses

Stark State College of Technology is pleased to offer both the 40-hour Hazardous Waste Operations and Emergency Response (HAZWOPER) and 8-hour HAZWOPER refresher training courses. These courses have been designed to comply with OSHA's Hazardous Waste Operations and Emergency Response (HAZWOPER) Standard for hazardous waste site workers 29 CFR Part 1910.120 (e).

These courses incorporate hands-on practice with equipment as well as traditional lectures. In-class exercises and take-home assignments will require students to choose appropriate equipment and procedures during table-top and hands-on exercises. Students will work together during in-class exercises in teams.

What makes these courses ideal for both industrial and consulting companies as well as regulatory personnel is the convenient manner in which they are offered.

The 40-hour HAZWOPER course consists of 24 hours of on-line training and 16 hours of hands-on training. The on-line portion of this course can be taken at a time and place of convenience for the course attendee. ***The remaining two days of hands-on training are given on a Friday and Saturday, limiting the amount of billable time or normal working hours loss to training to only one day or eight hours.***

The 8-hour refresher training coincides with the last day (Saturday) of the 40-hour training course. In this case, the amount of billable time or normal working hours loss to training is none.

Ohio residents not registered as Stark State students:

- Fee: \$305 40-hour training course
- Fee: \$185 8-hour refresher training course

Active Stark State students:

- Fee: \$240 40-hour training course
- Fee: \$120 8-hour refresher training course

Required book used for both courses:

\$37.50 plus tax and can be purchased through the Stark State College Bookstore prior to the first day of class.

- June 23 and 24
- October 20 and 21

8-hour HAZWOPER Refresher:

- April 8
- June 24
- October 21

Additional dates may be scheduled for groups of 10 or more.

Class credits are fully transferable and can be applied towards an associate degree.
