- A. Linda Morosko introduced Angel as an alternative for communication purposes to benefit student awareness of activities within an on-campus group. Linda showed various uses and abilities possible and invited three groups to become a “test pilot” for student’s use outside of the classroom. It was determined three groups would accept this trial use, while Cherie Barth will remain sole advisor to all groups. A vote was acquired unanimously. The groups decided are as follows:

- B. An email and paper survey pertaining to Stark State College Mascot will be delivered to students at the beginning of the spring 2009 semester. The questions will be as follows:
1. Would you like to see an official Spartan logo developed for the college?
  2. Would you like a contest open to the student body for creating the logo? If so, what kind of contest?
  3. Do you have any suggestions in regards to creating a Spartan logo for our college?
  4. Would you support a student activity fee attached to your tuition each semester/academic year that would be used to support student activities/programs?
  5. If so, how much would you be willing to have assessed each semester/academic year? \$5, \$10, \$15, or \$20?
- C. Once again, SSCT will support The United Way campaign on our campus. Collection cans will be placed around campus, emails will be sent to each student and flyers will be passed out for awareness during the spring 2009 semester. Our goal is to get something from each student (no matter how small). A unanimous vote was attained on this matter.

- D. Student Leadership Academy issues that possibly could or should be addressed to assist students in the future were discussed by SGA officers and Cherie Barth. The topics are as follows:
1. Generation Gap
  2. Males and Females are equal on diverse topics in and out of the classroom/work environments
  3. Cultural Diversity (race, region, religion)
- E. Stark State College has asked Student Government to help promote awareness and various upcoming activities. A vote to accept this promotion was unanimous.
1. Crime prevention
  2. Sexual assaults
  3. Self-defense programs

With no further items to be discussed, the meeting was adjourned at 4:30 p.m.
