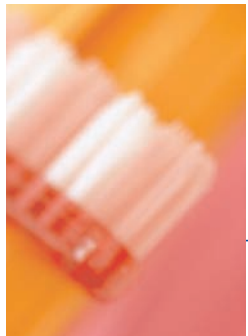
Medical history and Hepatitis-B inoculation will be required of all participants.
