A. SGA Bylaws re-wording per January meeting motions:

1. Dave Sigmund thoroughly defined
 - a. Article IV Section A - "Executive Committee" to be defined as the President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer
 - b. Article IV Section - D add 4. "Election of Officers" to read copy Section E 3. And modify to reflect officer.
 - c. Article IV Section E 3. Change members to senators
 - d. Article VI Section A and B - Article Rewritten as presented to clarify parameters for removal of officers and appointment said officers
 - e. Article VII - Delete entire article as it is redundant with Article VI. Re-number all following Articles to be in sequence
 - f. Article VIII Section C change - "...at least two times per semester" to "... at least two times per year."
2. This was the first reading of the proposed revised bylaws. The second reading will take place on Friday, March 13, 2009; at that time will be voted for final submission.

B. Stark State College Mascot Survey Update

1. Martina Catlin, SGA Secretary met with Mrs. Linda Studer, SSCT Graphic Design professor, on Monday, February 9, 2009 concerning Graphic Design students creating a flyer to raise awareness for an all SSCT student mascot contest. The request was accepted and will be completed by March 12, 2009. Martina Catlin will visit Mrs. Studer's Graphic Design class on Wednesday, February 25, 2009 @ 1:30 to promote the issue further and answer any questions for said flyer.
2. Mrs. Studer also offered to have the same Graphic Design class create SGA letterhead. Martina Catlin stated she would submit the offer to SGA officers. The offer was accepted by all officers.
3. Dave Sigmund suggested a name should also be considered for the mascot.

C. United Way SSCT Student Campaign #2
