The Student Government Association of Stark State College of Technology met on Tuesday, December 16, 2008. Members present included:

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A. SGA Bylaws

1. An official motion was made by Sandy Crossen to make Martina Catlin the official secretary officer of Stark State Student Government. The motion was unanimously passed by Dave Sigmund, Ashanti Metcalf, and Sandy Crossen.
2. A motion was made by Sandy Crossen to amend the bylaws, Article VI, Section B, to clarify the impeachment policy. A written proposal will be presented to SGA officers for approval in the near future, not to exceed February 28, 2009.
3. A motion was made by Dave Sigmund to amend the bylaws, Article VII, Section A, clarifying the appointment policy in the event of an officer vacancy. The motion was passed unanimously.

B. Stark State College Mascot Survey

1. Mr. Stillitano, SSCT Marketing Professor, invited the proposed student marketing SSCT mascot research survey to be completed by his marketing class as their semester project. The said survey will be implemented approximately in February 2009.
2. As a new service for SGA to be maximized, the above mentioned student marketing research survey will be placed on ANGEL for additional student participation.
3. Martina Catlin proposed asking Mr. Studer, SSCT Graphic Design Professor, to implement a contest for SSCT students to inspire student completion of said mascot. She graciously accepted, and their contest flyer will begin sometime in February 2009.
4. Cherie Barth suggested the student winner of the mascot contest could receive a SSCT bookstore gift card. She will be looking onto this matter for more details.
5. Completion of flyer and mascot logo will be decided at a later time.

- C. United Way SSCT Student Campaign #2
 - 1. Tables will be set up around the campus buildings (cafeteria, Health, Business, and the Timken building) for all four SGA officers to work a table throughout a week during the campaign. Tentative dates are February 9, 10, 11, and 12, 2009.
 - 2. A table set up in the Atrium was considered for additional coverage.
 - 3. A club challenge will be implemented.

- D. A motion was made by Sandy Crossen to have an SGA Table Banner made for school functions. As there are sufficient funds available, this motion was passed unanimously.
- E. ANGEL use for SGA was recapped and it is understood that it is still in progress. There will be a learning seminar available by Linda Morosco for officers of the three groups offered to test for student group purposes.
- F. The Welcome Back/Student Activities Service Fair will be held on February 26, 2009, 11 a.m. – 2 p.m. This will be held in the cafeteria and all SSCT groups will be welcome to set up a table for student awareness.
- G. Student Leadership Academy will start Wednesday, February 4, 2009. Topics available this semester will include
 - 1. Teambuilding
 - 2. Etiquette luncheon
 - 3. Stress management
 - 4. Serve and Lead
