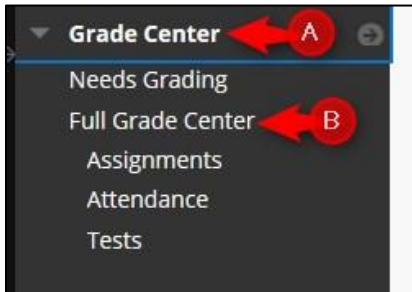


Grading Schemas in Blackboard

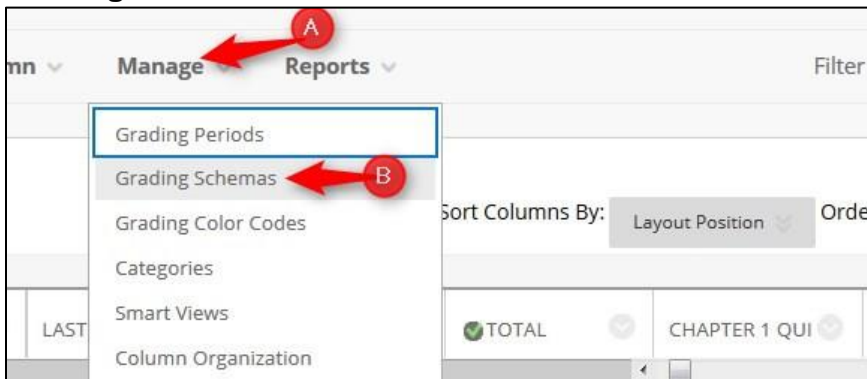
There is a college approved grading schema in Blackboard called Standard Grading Scale. You can also add additional grading schemas or edit the default one.

Directions:

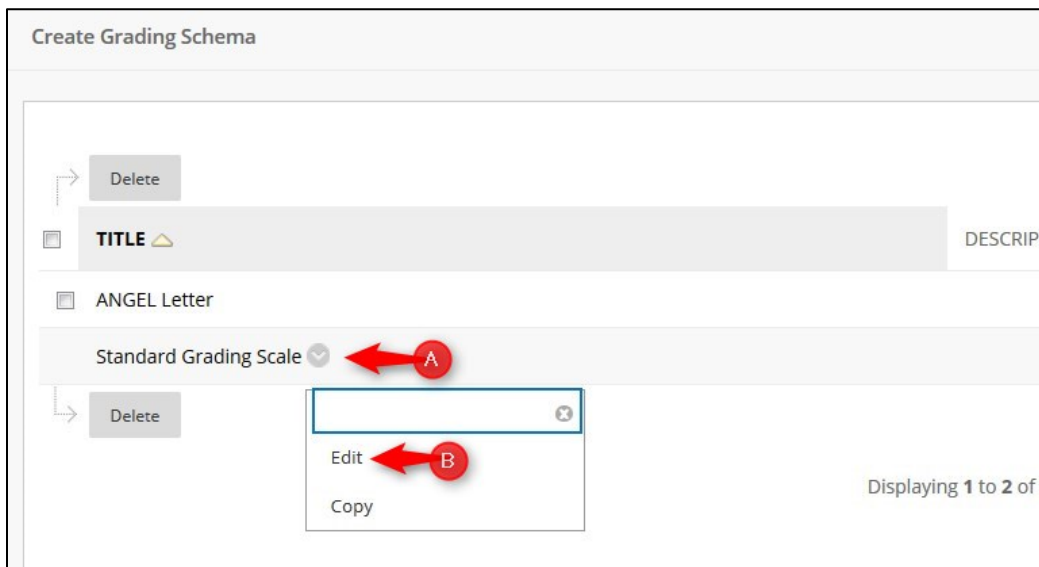
1. In your course - Click **Grade Center** and then **Full Grade Center**



2. To review the default grading schema – Standard Grading Scale – Click **Manage** and then **Grading Schemas**.



3. Click the **down arrow** by the Standard Grading Scale and then click **Edit**.



4. After reviewing the Standard Grading Scale, click **Cancel** to exit the window.
