

How to use a Bb Test Pool Generator

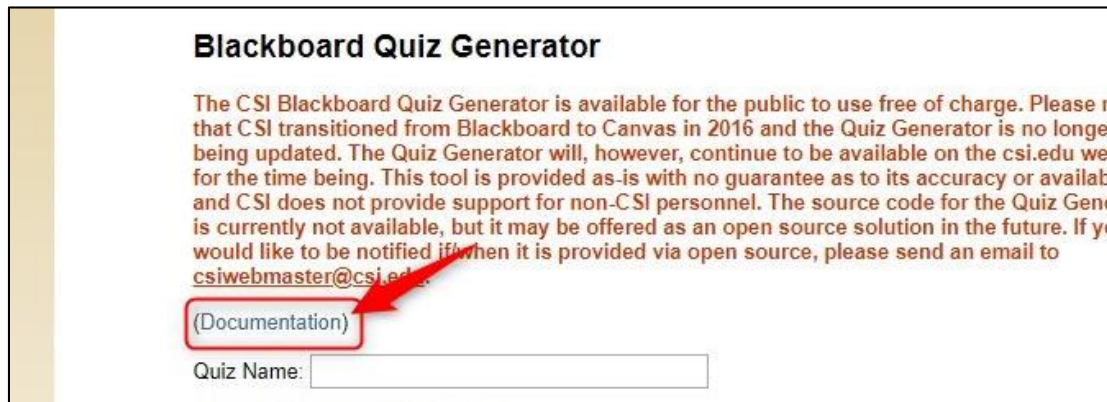
There is a Free Bb Test Pool Generator website provided by College of Southern Idaho.

Directions:

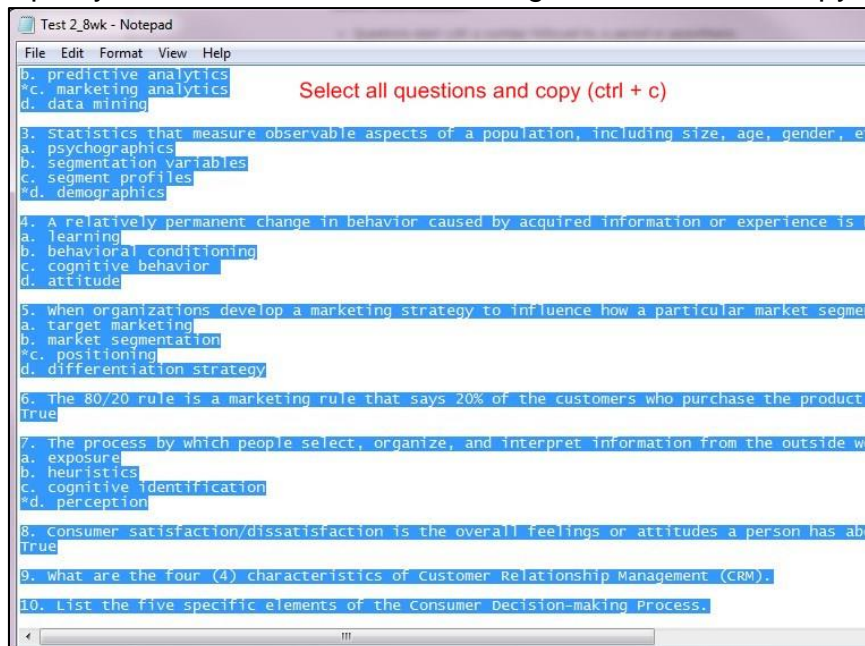
1. Click on the link to open the Test Generator Page.

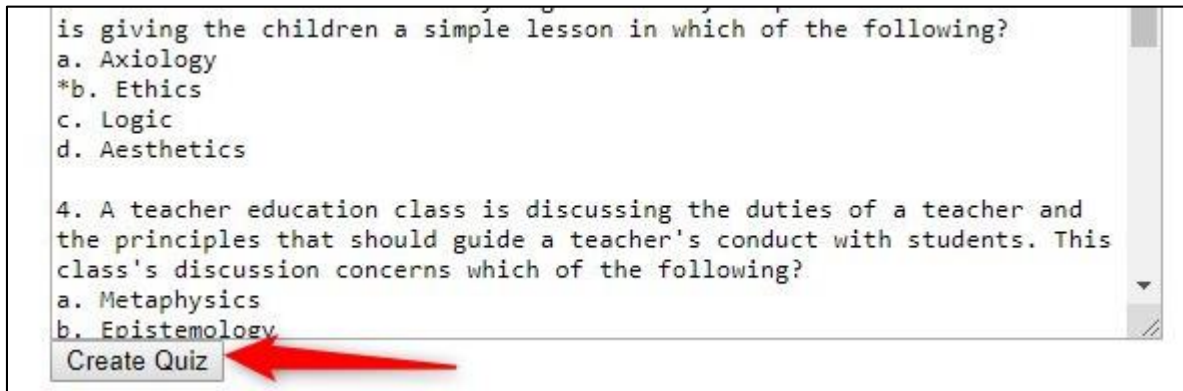

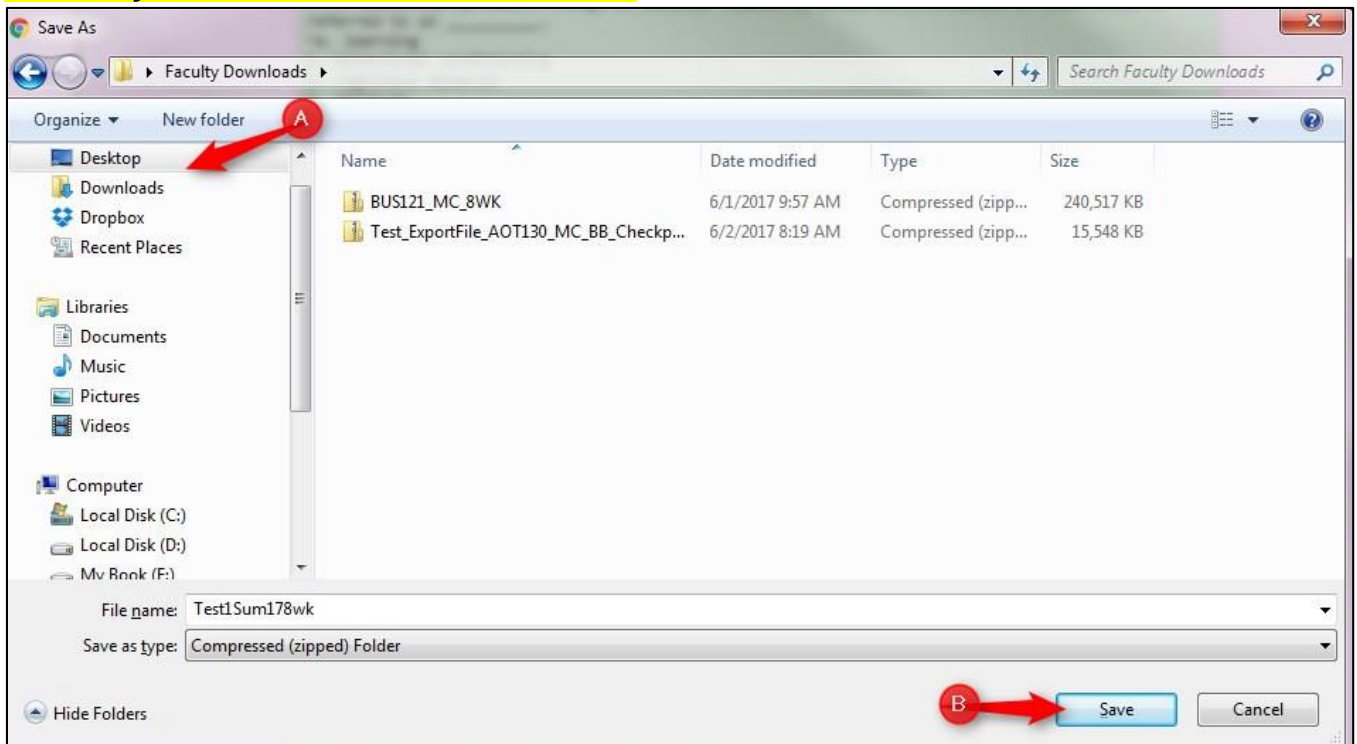
