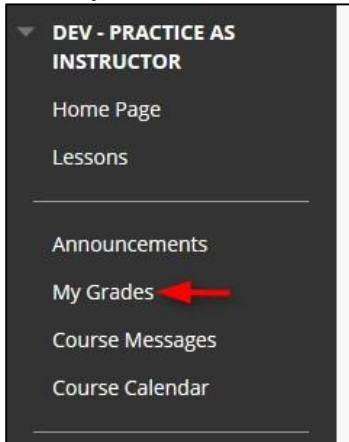


# How Do I view graded assignments?
