Accessing Your Accounts

Computer Sign-On Information:

User Name – first initial of first name, last name, two-digit birth month, and two-digit birth day. Password – first initial of first, middle, last name, period, and first six of your social security. Example: Fred M. Smith was born on June 15 with social security number 215-85-4372 User Name – fsmith0615 Password – fms.215854

Email Information:

Email address – first initial of first name, last name, two-digit birth month, and two-digit birth day followed by @starkstate.net

Example: Fred M. Smith was born on June 15

Email address – fsmith0615@starkstate.net



- 1. Open a web browser (**RECOMMENDED BROWSERS**: Chrome, Edge, Firefox. Do **NOT** use Safari).
- 2. On the address bar, type http://mail.google.com/hosted/starkstate.net.

4. Enter your **Password** and click Next.



How to Access Courses:

- 1. Open a web browser (Chrome, Edge, Firefox).
- 2. On the address bar, type **blackboard.starkstate.edu**.



3. Enter your SSC email address and click on Next.



4. Enter your **password** and click on **Sign In**. This is the same password as your computer sign-on.




5. You will receive a message saying, "More Information Required." Click on Next.



The Digital Library


Providing quality resources and professional library information services to help with your research and learning. You can access one-on-one assistance for online research, live online reference help, and scholarly databases.

mySSC


