



Thank you for the interest that you have expressed in the Judicial Court Reporting program at Stark State College. As you may know, Stark State College and Clark State Community College have partnered to offer this completely online associate's degree program. You may also elect to take some courses in the curriculum in person at either Stark State College or Clark State.

From the beginning of the program, students in the Judicial Court Reporting program will be writing realtime on a Student Realtime machine—called a Stentura Wave—that is cabled to a computer through a USB connection. Translation of the steno language into English is instantaneous, and the student will be using the equipment every day. Therefore, students will be required to purchase their own equipment. Students are not required to buy new equipment—buying used equipment is permitted if the equipment meets the necessary course requirements. IMPORTANT: MAC computer are not compatible with Case CATalyst.

As the judicial reporting program requires a major investment and commitment on the part of the student, we encourage you to learn as much about the profession as you can before you sign up. Following is the step-by-step process to help you get started in your new educational path. # **Step 1 - Apply**. Please go to the website: <a href="http://www.starkstate.edu/admissions">http://www.starkstate.edu/admissions</a>

Clink the link "APPLY NOW". Apply for a pin as a new student. Please fill out the online application in its entirety. When you get to the section asking for your major, you need to click on the drop down arrow and click on "Judicial Court Reporting." If you have questions, please contact the Stark State Admissions Office at (330) 494-6170, x4228, or 1-800-797-8275.

# Step 2 - Transcripts

If you would like to transfer high school (College Credit Plus) or college credits, Stark State will need an **official copy** of your high school and college transcripts sent directly from your high school and your previous college(s) to the Stark State Admissions Office, 6200 Frank Avenue, N.W., North Canton, OH 44720. Upon receiving an official transcript, Stark State will evaluate it for transfer credit.

# **Step 3 - Placement Testing**

Once you're admitted, please provide your ACT scores (if you've taken the test within the last two years) or set up an appointment to take the COMPASS assessment. # Step 4 - Financial Aid

If you need help paying for your education, you'll need to complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) to apply for financial aid. # Step 5 - Orientation (on campus or online)

Students are required to complete a new student orientation before you can register for classes. You will need your student identification number to reserve your seat.

### **IMPORTANT NOTE:**

Case CATalyst will run on a MAC computer but a version of Windows must be installed.

Stenograph recommends using a utility that comes with MACs called Boot Camp. This utility helps create space on the hard drive so that Windows can be installed in addition to the MAC OS. After Windows has been installed on the computer, you can boot to Windows and run Case CATalyst in a pure Windows environment just like a PC.

Stenograph does not recommend using programs like VMware Fusion or Parallels Desktop as these programs run inside the MAC Operating System. This setup can cause issues with the





amount of system resources allocated to run Windows, the MAC OS, and Case CATalyst at the same time.

Before using Boot Camp, make sure that your MAC meets the **System Requirements**.
