


College and career fair planning



Prior to meeting with college representatives, students and parents should establish a list of priorities. To make a realistic selection of a college or university, consider these factors:

- // admission requirements
- // public or private
- // cost
- // nature of the student population
- // location
- // enrollment
- // majors offered

Be prepared



Many representatives will ask you for your name and address so they can send you additional information. Create a list of questions to ask by using these topics as a guide:

THE COLLEGE

- // Where is the college located (urban, rural)?
- // What is the surrounding community like?
- // Is the college public, private or parochial?
- // What special programs are offered?
- // Does the college have general education requirements?
- // Is the college on semesters or quarters?
- // Does the college offer summer classes?
- // Where do the majority of students come from?

ACADEMICS

- // What is the average class size? Smallest? Largest?
- // How many students complete a degree?
- // Does the college offer career advising and job placement?
- // Do students graduate in four or five years?
- // What are the most popular majors?
- // Are students taught by full-time faculty members or teaching assistants?
- // What percent of graduates are accepted into graduate school?
- // Are academic advising services available?

ADMISSION POLICIES

- // What high school courses are required?
- // What entrance tests are required and what are acceptable scores?
- // Does the college require a certain grade point average or rank in class?
- // Will my activities and involvement in high school be considered?
- // Is there an early decision or early action plan?
- // What decision making process is used?
- // Are personal interviews, essays or letters of recommendation required?
- // Are there special requirements for impacted majors?
- // What percent of applicants are admitted?
- // Can admission denials be appealed?
- // What are the application filing dates?
- // What is the current enrollment?

STUDENT POPULATION

- // What types of activities are available?
- // Do most of the students commute or live on campus?
- // Are there sororities and fraternities on campus?
- // What athletic programs are available?
- // Is the surrounding community supportive of the college?
- // Does the campus have a visitation program?
- // Is housing guaranteed for freshmen?

FINANCIAL AID

- // What financial aid form does the college require?
- // What percent of students receive financial aid?
- // When are the financial aid filing deadlines?
- // Does the college offer on-campus student employment?
- // What types of grants, scholarships and loans are available?
- // How is financial aid awarded?
- // Are there special scholarships for leadership, athletics, the arts or academic achievement?
