<p>SYMPTOMS of COVID-19</p> <p>PLEASE STAY AT HOME IF YOU ARE SICK.</p>	<p>The CDC states, people with COVID-19 have had a wide range of symptoms reported – ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness. Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus.</p> <p>People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fever or chills • Cough • Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing • Fatigue • Muscle or body aches • Headache • New loss of taste or smell • Sore throat • Congestion or runny nose • Nausea or vomiting • Diarrhea <p>*This list does not include all possible symptoms. <p>FACULTY & STAFF</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If a student, faculty or staff member reports off to you due to COVID-19 exposure, symptoms, or confirmed case report the information to the response team immediately. 330-494-6170 ext. 6000 or responseteam@starkstate.edu • If approached by a student or employee stating they have been exposed, a member of their family is exposed, are experiencing symptoms, or a confirmed case advise them to go home & stay home until contacted by a SSC response team member. • After the student or employee has been advised please report the information to the response team immediately, 330-494-6170 ext. 6000 or responseteam@starkstate.edu.
<p>STUDENTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you are experiencing symptoms, exposed to COVID-19, or have tested positive for COVID-19, STAY HOME. Take care of yourself by monitoring your symptoms and stay in touch with your doctor. • Contact the SSC Response Team to report an exposure, symptoms, or that you have tested positive (330-494-6170 ext. 6000 or responseteam@starkstate.edu). A team member will contact you with further guidance and/or answer questions. • Contact your instructor(s) for any missed assignments or tests. Notifying the instructor is the student's responsibility.
<p>PREVENTION</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stay home if you are sick • Practice good hand hygiene, cough, and sneeze etiquette • Wear a face covering/mask • Use hand sanitizer (stations are located throughout the college) • Avoid touching your eyes, nose, mouth with unwashed hands
