



## One free class for spring '21 second 8 weeks -available to all new and current students-

Priority application date is March 12, 2021

### Process

- New students must apply to the College and enroll in a spring second 8-week class
- All students must complete the 2020-2021 [FAFSA](#)
- Student must complete the *Free Tuition* application – available electronically on [mystarkstate](#) (under the My Stuff tab)
- **Complete all required steps above by March 12 for priority processing**
- Tuition is awarded via disbursement to student account after non-attendance drop date for the second 8-week semester (approximately April 5)

### Details

- Maximum tuition award amount of 4 credit hours/one class = \$720
- Does not include other fees or books (these items are the responsibility of the student)
- Students currently enrolled for second 8 weeks are eligible to apply for a free class, as well as new registrants and new students
- If a student has already enrolled and paid for a second 8-week class, once their *Free Tuition* application has been approved, they would receive a credit balance resulting in a refund.
- The priority application date is March 12, 2021
- Spring second 8-week semester begins March 22.
- Students must attend class to qualify for funding consideration
- Awards made on a funds-available basis
- College Credit Plus students and students choosing to audit classes for no credit are not eligible for these funds
- Funded by the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act – Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund II (HEERF II)
