



**More than 50% off for spring semester 2022  
(\$100 award per credit hour)**

- all students – current and new
- any major
- online and on campus
- applications accepted through Feb. 2, 2022 (no exceptions)

**Process**

1. Students must apply and be accepted to Stark State and register for spring 2022 classes
2. Students are encouraged to complete the 2021-22 Free Application for Federal Student Aid ([FAFSA](#)) to be considered for additional funding\*
3. Students must complete the *spring 2022 \$100 off* application form electronically on [mystarkstate](#) under the My Stuff tab
4. Final awards will be reviewed and disbursed to student accounts after the never-attend drop date (week of Feb. 7)

**Details**

- Students must register for spring semester classes and apply for funding by Feb. 2, 2022 to receive \$100 off per credit hour
- Spring semester begins Jan. 18, 2022
- Students remain eligible for Pell grants
- Students must meet all eligibility requirements for enrollment and registration according to Stark State policies and procedures to be eligible for this program
- Once submitted, students will receive a notification of application receipt
- Students must attend classes
- Final award eligibility will be determined by credit hour enrollment after the never-attends drop date (Feb. 2, 2022)

**\*ADDITIONAL FUNDS AVAILABLE**

**Additional funding is available for students with exceptional need shown by**

- a completed 2021-2022 FAFSA demonstrating Pell eligibility
- loss of employment (self or household member)
- benefits from federal need-based programs

*This aid used can be used for any costs of attendance or other needs such as food, housing, health care or child care.*
