Introduction: This agreement details the <u>applicability</u> of courses from the Stark State College AAS Occupational Therapy Assistant to the BS Health Sciences: Pre-Occupational Therapy (Online) in the UC College of Allied Health Sciences. Students who complete the AAS Occupational Therapy Assistant at Stark State College have satisfied the UC General Education requirement.

A maximum of 70 semester hours transferred from Stark State College will apply toward the 120 semester hours required for the BS Health Sciences: Pre-Occupational Therapy (Online). Students earning less than 70 semester hours will be required to take additional coursework at UC to meet the total of 120 semester hours for graduation.

Articulation Overview: Graduates from Stark State College who have followed the prescribed program, completed the AAS, and are accepted into the College of Allied Health Sciences will enter at junior standing in the BS Health Sciences: Pre-Occupational Therapy (Online) program. All degree requirements are completed online.

Stark State College warrants that it is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission. The College will notify University of Cincinnati if such accreditation ceases to exist. University of Cincinnati warrants that it is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission. University of Cincinnati will notify Stark State College if such accreditation ceases to exist.

Appropriate publications and promotional materials regarding this agreement will be made available to Stark State College students.

Admission Criteria: *Note: completing the courses on the addendums below does not guarantee admission to the UC BS Health Sciences: Pre-Occupational Therapy (Online) program.

A student must:

- Hold an AAS degree from the Occupational Therapy Assistant program at Stark State College.
- Hold credentials as an occupational therapy assistant as certified by the National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy; conditional acceptance is granted into the program for those who are eligible to take the OTA exam and have a plan in place to complete the exam.
- Complete a UC application (including submission of official transcripts from all institutions attended and payment of application fee).
- Pay UC's matriculation fee.

Minimum GPA: 2.5

Admission Period: Stark State College students must be admitted to the UC College of Allied Health Sciences during the duration of this agreement (i.e. between September 2020 and September 2023).

Agreement Execution Date: September 2020 Agreement End Date: September 2023

EXECUTION, DURATION AND REVIEW OF AGREEMENT:

This agreement becomes effective upon its signing by both Colleges and <u>will remain effective for three years</u>. At the end of this time, the agreement will be reviewed and may be renegotiated. Stark State College and the UC College of Allied Health Sciences agree to keep one another informed as program changes affecting the agreement occur. Both Colleges will agree upon any future additions and/or amendments to this document in writing.

TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT



This agreement will be reviewed on an annual basis and is subject to change due to revisions in program curriculum. This agreement does not preclude either institution from making a curriculum change if deemed appropriate by the institution making the change.

This agreement is not exclusive, and either party may enter into similar agreements with any other party. This agreement may be dissolved at any time upon mutual agreement by either institution. Further, either party may terminate this agreement for its convenience, without further liability or obligation to the other party, by providing the other party thirty (30) days' prior written notice.

Stark State College students are encouraged to work closely with their academic advisor to monitor possible changes.
