English Transfer Pathway

for Ohio Community College students transferring to Denison University

November 2022

This document outlines the Ohio Guaranteed Transfer Pathway (OGTP) in English that has been designed to provide clarity and consistency for college courses transferring between Ohio 2-year and 4-year public institutions.

DENISON

This same transfer pathway in English is now approved for students transferring to Denison University, through a partnership between 11 Ohio community colleges and 14 private colleges called the <u>Ohio Consortium for Transfer Pathways to the Liberal</u> <u>Arts</u>, and whose faculty and administration have collaborated to expand access and credit clarity for students transferring with an associate's degree from an Ohio community college to an Ohio private college or university.

Pages 1 & 2 of this document outline **community college courses that are approved statewide** for transfer credit toward the bachelor of arts degree in English at an approved 4-year institution. Pages 3-7 show how these courses transfer to Denison University to meet bachelor degree requirements.

Where it indicates "Any OT36 approved," students should work closely with their advisors.

¹ Courses below the Calculus level will not transfer to Denison. Any Math course must be at or beyond the Calculus level.

² Social Sciences at Denison include: Anthropology, Communication, Economics, Educational Studies, Political Science, and Sociology. Psychology will not fulfill a Social Science requirement at Denison and normally would only transfer as general credit.

² 2 Denison recommends that the additional credits take the form of 1 interdisciplinary course, 1 additional Humanities course, 1 additional Arts course, or 1 Oral Communication course.

Advising Notes:

¹ A minimum of two semesters of foreign language should be taken if available. Additional foreign language courses may be needed as well – check with your receiving institution. If more foreign language courses are taken, then the number of elective hours will be lower.

² Denison recommends that electives be used to fulfill GE requirements in the form of 1 interdisciplinary courses, 1 additional Humanities course, 1 additional Arts course, or 1 Oral Communication course.

SPECIAL NOTES

Some bachelor-degree granting programs may be competitive and admission into the program is not guaranteed. Students should check with individual institutions for their program admission requirements.

Some bachelor-degree granting institutions require additional general education courses outside of the Ohio Transfer 36 and students may be required to take these courses in their junior or senior year. Students will still be able to follow this pathway and complete their bachelor's degree in approximately 60 additional credit hours.

How English Pathway Courses Transfer to Denison University

A student transferring to Denison University with the English transfer pathway and Associate of Arts degree completed will receive maximum transfer credit, placing them at or near junior standing. Most or all of the Denison University general education requirements and introductory major courses can be completed as part of the associate degree, through planning with a transfer advisor. Students interested in transferring to Denison University should meet with an admission counselor regarding optimal course selection and admission requirements.

¹Courses below the Calculus level will not transfer to Denison. Any Math course must be at or beyond the Calculus level.

²Denison recommends that electives be used to fulfill GE requirements in the form of 1 interdisciplinary course, 1 additional Humanities course, 1 additional Arts course, or 1 Oral Communication course.

Students will need to take a minimum of two semesters of a foreign language or waive the requirement via a placement exam. If the selected language was previously studied, students will need to complete through the third semester of language study. If the selected language is a new language of study, students will need to complete through the second semester of language study. Students will meet with the Dean of Transfer Students to discuss fulfillment of Denison's competencies requirements in Power & Justice, Oral Communication, and Quantitative Reasoning.

Advising Notes:

The English – Literature major requirements outlined above assume that a student has taken the minimum of two English courses as part of their AA degree, meaning that they would need to take an additional eight courses at Denison to meet our degree requirements.

Students must complete two 200-level courses in literature before 1900. Depending on which OGTP English courses are taken at the two-year institution, students will need to complete this requirement in their Denison coursework. (For instance, if a student takes both American Literature II and British Literature II, they will need to take two 200-level pre-1900 literature courses at Denison; if a student takes both American Literature I, they will need to take two 200-level pre-1900 literature courses at Denison; if a student takes both American Literature I and British Literature I and British Literature I, they will have satisfied this departmental requirement before transferring to Denison.)

In addition, at least one of the student's ten total English courses must be in a historically marginalized or traditionally underrepresented literary tradition. Such a course also counts toward the students 200-level or 300-level requirements.

If a student takes more than the minimum two English courses as part of their AA degree, those additional courses may transfer to Denison in various ways, depending on the specific courses in question.

Advising Notes:

The English – Creative Writing major requirements outlined above assume that a student has taken the minimum of two English courses as part of their AA degree, meaning that they would need to take an additional eight courses at Denison to meet our degree requirements.

Students must complete the core workshop sequence (ENGL 237; ENGL 383/384/385; and ENGL 453-454) in residence at Denison. Students must complete their 300-level workshop before the end of their junior year, and senior students may not enroll in a 300-level workshop while they are also enrolled in ENGL 453-454.

Assuming students take just two core English courses at their two-year institution, students will need to complete one additional 200-level course. Depending on which OGTP English courses are taken at the two-year institution, students will perhaps need to take a 200-level course in literature before 1900. (For instance, if a student takes both American Literature II and British Literature II, they will need to take a pre-1900 literature course at Denison.)

In addition, at least one of the student's ten total English courses must be in a historically marginalized or traditionally underrepresented literary tradition. Such a course also counts toward the students 200-level or 300-level requirements.

If a student takes more than the minimum two English courses as part of their AA degree, those additional courses may transfer to Denison in various ways, depending on the specific courses in question.
