University of Mount Union Transfer Notes:

Total number of hours needed to graduate is a "minimum of" 120.

Math Proficiency would be met with MTH 124 through SSC.

Students must complete a minimum of 48 hours at Mount Union, of which a minimum of 16 in the major and 8 in the minor are required.

Each student must contact the IC Director to develop a plan and schedule for the second-year Raider Foundation Portfolio (RFP).

A minor is required at Mount Union or students can look to double major and/or have multiple minors (please consult with your UMU advisor).

Foreign language proficiency can be met with a proficiency exam OR by taking the 200-level course in SPN at Stark State. If students tested proficient or successfully passed these courses, no courses would be needed at Mount Union. If not, the student would need to take one or two foreign language courses.

Students transferring 48 credits or above may transfer up to all 4 foundation courses and students transferring in 47 credits or below may only transfer up to 2 foundations courses. Students transferring to Mount Union with an earned associate degree from a regionally accredited institution will have a large portion of their general education requirements waived (*Foundation courses and RFP*).
