Students who did not complete the courses in high school, and those who prefer to refresh their knowledge of the material, should complete the listed pre-requisites.

#Applicants may select a dental assisting course option in which to gain specialized skills: Dental Office Management, Community Dentistry or Clinical Dental Assisting. Required course in the Associate of Science Degree in Dental Assisting.

\*\*Course may be taken in conjunction with other technical courses, but must be taken in the first semester of technical course work.

Minimum grade of "C" in all concentration courses is required.

This program requires an application (separate from the College). Please see your advisor to discuss the application process.

Students completing this degree may be eligible to also receive a Dental Assisting Career-Enhancement Certificate (3403).
