Who is this scholarship designed for?

The Great Minds Fellowship is ideal for students looking to make a difference and contribute to expanding Ohio's behavioral health workforce. The program will help students jump-start a successful future in their chosen career path while allowing committees across Ohio to better care for those living with mental health and substance abuse disorders.

Who is eligible for this scholarship?

Eligible students must be Ohio residents and within two years of graduating with an undergraduate or graduate degree in human and social services or chemical dependency. They must commit to serving Medicaid enrollees in the community for one year either through an internship or upon graduation. Students are required to sign an agreement with the state of Ohio committing to this requirement.

What can these funds apply toward?

Scholarship funds should be used for costs associated with the student's education, including internship/work-based learning experiences.

When is this scholarship available?

Scholarships are available now.

What is the purpose of this scholarship?

This program intends to strengthen, grow or build behavioral health workforce programs, either independently or in a collaborative model. It involves educational institutions and health centers that provide home and community-based behavioral health services in Ohio Health Improvement Zones or U.S. Human Resources and Services Administration Mental Health Shortage areas.
