Stark State College A History of Educational Excellence

Stark State College was founded in 1960 when computerization and the development of new technologies and companies created a need for well-educated, highly trained employees with two-year college degrees. Stark State College was born out of that need. Well-respected in the community, Stark State College plays a vital role in the economic growth and development of the region through its strong tradition of providing educational and training services to employers and residents.

Today, Stark State College offers over 200 associate degrees, one-year certificates and career enhancement certificates in business and entrepreneurial studies, education, liberal arts, mathematics, engineering technologies, information technology, health and public services, and sciences.

Degrees awarded are the associate of arts, associate of science, associate of applied science, associate of applied business and associate of technical studies. These degrees prepare our graduates for career success as they move directly into the workforce or choose to continue their education in pursuit of a baccalaureate degree. A wide range of short-term career enhancement certificates help employees improve skills and gain a competitive edge in a society with rapidly changing technology. Career enhancement certificates lead to associate degrees and one-year certificates in various fields of study.

Community and business partnerships are vital to Stark State College. The College has developed an outstanding reputation among business and industry for its willingness to aggressively enhance workforce development activities in support of emerging business needs. A few of Stark State College's public/private partnerships include The Timken Co., Diebold Nixdorf, Contained Energy, Lockheed Martin, Kohler Container Co. and Ariel Corporation.

The Stark State College Foundation is a non-profit, tax-exempt organization that provides financial support beyond that obtained through student fees and state allocations. The Foundation exists solely to benefit the students and programs of Stark State College and assists the College in reaching a higher level of excellence in serving the educational needs of our community.

More than 17,000 Stark State College graduates live and work in our community, contributing to the vitality of our region and serving as a true testament to Stark State's commitment to excellence in education.

The Academic Processional

The academic processional precedes the graduation ceremonies and reflects the early origins of education. To recognize the achievements of their students, higher education institutions in America hold an official commencement, during which time students are awarded appropriate degrees at the completion of their studies.

Academic costume has a history of nearly eight centuries. As students in medieval Europe organized into guilds, they developed distinctive costumes for various degrees. Differences among this garb appeared mainly in the hood, which is derived from the cloak. Hoods are now ornamental and are draped over the shoulders and down the back. The hood is faced with colors, which denote the field of study represented by the wearer's degree. The colors of the lining are those of the college or university by which the degree was granted.

In Europe, a professor generally wears the type of garment customary in the university where he or she is lecturing. In the U.S., professors continue to wear the gown and hood of the university where they received the highest degree.

The cap, or mortarboard, is thought to have been created in the 15th century. In the U.S., caps are generally flat and square-shaped. A tassel is attached to a button on top of the mortarboard. Tassels for associate and bachelor's degrees are black, while those for master's degrees are black or a color appropriate to the major field of study. For doctoral degrees, tassels are black or gold. The tassel is moved from the right side of the cap to the left side after receiving a degree and worn on the left side by those who have recieved a degree.

The various colors of the hoods signify the field of study in which the degree is earned. For example: white – arts in letters and humanities, olive – business and commerce, light blue – education, orange – engineering, purple – law, golden yellow – science, apricot – nursing, lemon – library science, pink – music, and green – medicine.

Distinction and High Distinction

Graduates who have demonstrated outstanding accomplishment in their technologies will be announced as graduating either with distinction or high distinction.

Graduates who have a grade point average of 3.4 or above will graduate with distinction.

Graduates who have a grade point average of 3.8 or above will graduate with high distinction.

The level of distinction is based on the grade point average at the end of the semester preceding graduation. If the level of distinction changes after final grades are posted for the graduating semester, the student's academic record will be updated.

History and Tradition of the Mace

The ceremonial mace that is used in college and university commencement exercises was originally a weapon designed to protect kings that dates back to 12,000 B.C. Throughout history, the mace also has been a symbol of royalty and justice. Though maces traditionally were used as weapons, Scottish maces are musical instruments and have been and continue to be used as instruments of wartime music and military bands. The mace also is a symbol of academic authority. In commencement ceremonies, the mace is carried before the president and dignitaries who are seated at the platform where the graduates receive their diplomas.

The Construction and Symbolism of the Stark State College Mace

Stark State College's commencement mace is handcrafted from cherry wood, salvaged from a fallen tree on Stark State College's campus. The mace is 50 inches long and weighs 16 pounds. It was turned in March of 2006 by local craftsman Merle Weber. The Massillon Plaque Company fabricated the metal castings on the mace to the College's specifications.

The foundation for the head of the mace is constructed of Ohio flint, a crypto-crystalline quartz and the state's official gemstone. The mace is crowned on both the obverse and reverse sides, with the official logo of the College.

Four brass bands on the staff are engraved with the four names of the College and the dates associated with those names, capturing the College's history and development since its founding in 1960. Three cast-brass plates affixed to the large barrel section near the top of the mace symbolize the College's national and state affiliations. The first cast-brass plate depicts the United States flag. Symbolizing our state college status, the next casting displays the state motto and the final casting displays the Great Seal of the State of Ohio.

Shammas Malik

Mayor Shammas Malik was sworn in as Akron's 63rd mayor on Jan. 1, 2024. He is Akron's youngest mayor and first mayor of color. His platform focuses on key initiatives that make up his Together for Akron plan: a unifying vision for the city's future, rooted in safe neighborhoods, good schools, affordable homes, equitable economic opportunity and environmental sustainability. Through all of these initiatives, Mayor Malik is dedicated to communication and transparency as pillars of his administration.

Growing up in northwest Akron, Mayor Malik learned about the importance of public service from his mom, Dr. Helen Qammar, who taught chemical engineering at The University of Akron. After participating in the International Baccalaureate program at Firestone High School, Mayor Malik received a scholarship to The Ohio State University. He then went on to graduate from Harvard Law School. Mayor Malik came home in 2016 and dedicated his career to public service, first as an assistant director of Law for the city, and then as the elected representative to City Council for Ward 8. In 2019, Mayor Malik successfully ran for Akron City Council in the neighborhood where he grew up. In September of 2022, he announced he was running for mayor.
