

# Getting Started - Student Network Accounts and IT Information

This help aid is a copy of the *Getting Started*... brochure that is mailed to all new students.

It covers a brief overview of your different IT accounts, how to access them and other IT resources available to you.

For detailed account information, sign into the <u>Help Desk Services website</u>: <a href="https://helpdesk.starkstate.edu">https://helpdesk.starkstate.edu</a>. Click on the *Student Help* section, and view the articles in the *Student Accounts* category.

All students have several accounts created when accepted and enrolled in a credited course(s) at Stark State College.

- Your student email and mySSC accounts are created within 24 48 hours after you are accepted to the College.
- Your Campus Network and Brightspace accounts are created within 24 48 hours of enrolling for a course.

## **User Name and Password**

All of the accounts use the same format for the *User Name* and the initial default *Password*. Please note that most accounts prompt you to enter your email address as the user name. Enter your entire email address when prompted, otherwise, use the basic username only format below.

Your *User Name* is the first initial of your first name, your last name, your two-digit birth month and two-digit birth day.

**Example**: Fredrick M. Last, born on June 15, 1992, would be flast0615

NOTE: If your *User Name* duplicates that of a previously enrolled student, the birth *day* portion of the number will be incremented until a unique user name is assigned to your account.

Your default Password is your first, middle, last initial, period, and the first six digits of your social security number.

**Example**: using the above user information, and if Fred's social security number is

123-45-6789, the password would be fml.123456

NOTE: if you did not provide a middle name or initial, use an "x" for your middle initial.

# **IMPORTANT Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA)**

The first time you sign on, you are prompted for more information. You're required to change your password and setup multi-factor authentication (MFA). # Single Sign-On (SSO)

SSO allows a user to use a single user ID to sign on once and access their other SSC accounts during the same session without entering their account information again. Your SSC accounts use single sign-on.

#### **Email Account**

Once accepted to the College, an email account is created for you. Your email is used as an official means of communication.

Go to <a href="http://accounts.google.com">http://accounts.google.com</a> and log on using your UserName@starkstate.net and your current Password.

You may also access your email by clicking the *Access Your Email* link at <u>starkstate.edu/current-students/helpdesk/email</u> or go to any Gmail Sign in page, or clicking the email link in *Tools* in *my*SSC. This account uses single sign-on.

# **Google G Suite**

Along with your email account, you get Google's G Suite of secure integrated applications that include; Gmail, Docs, Drive, Calendar and many additional apps. Use your email account to sign in and access the applications. This account uses single sign-on.

#### **Drive home folder**

Your email account provides access to Google's G Suite. Use the *Drive* application as your home folder to save your files. Files are available anywhere you have Internet access. This account uses single sign-on.

### **Campus Network account**

All students enrolled in a course are issued a *Campus Network* account. The account is used to access the STARKSTATE academic network available on classroom computers and all public lounge area computers. This account is used to authenticate other accounts using single sign-on.

# **Printing on Campus**

Students are provided a specific amount of free printing in campus computer labs each semester. You may purchase additional printing credit in the form of *Top Up* cards at the College Store.

# eStarkState Brightspace account

Once enrolled in a course, your Brightspace account is created. Go to <a href="https://ess.starkstate.edu">https://ess.starkstate.edu</a>. Use the format <a href="https://ess.starkstate.edu">UserName@starkstate.net</a> and the current <a href="https://ess.starkstate.edu">Password</a> to sign-on. This account uses single sign-on.

The Brightspace account is used to attend Web 3 or Web 4 courses. Web 2 courses use Brightspace for a portion of class time and all other courses use Brightspace at the discretion of the instructor.

# **Help Desk Services website account**

The Help Desk Services website contains detailed help aids and videos for IT resources. Visit <a href="helpdesk.starkstate.edu">helpdesk.starkstate.edu</a>. Your user name is in email format; <a href="mailto:username@starkstate.net">username@starkstate.net</a> and use your current password. This account uses single sign-on. The Help Desk website is available 24/7.

# mySSC account

All students have a mySSC account. Go to <u>mySSC.starkstate.edu.</u> Use the format <u>username@starkstate.net</u> and your current password. This account uses single sign-on.
