## **Graduation Requirements**

Requirements to graduate with the BSE degree program: To graduate, students must have minimum 123 credit hours, 39 upper-division credits hours of coursework, a minimum 2.000 major GPA and minimum 2.750 cumulative GPA. They must also fulfill an approved experiential learning experience, a two-course diversity requirement (domestic and global), complete a writing intensive course with a minimum C (2.000) grade.
