APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Follow the procedures for applying to Stark State College (SSC).
2. Meet with an Admissions Counselor for review of transcripts and advising.
3. Review the program application requirements.
4. Refer to program website at www.starkstate.edu/academics/programs/respiratory-care/ to review program information including: the program overview, tentative student schedule, estimated program costs, and frequently asked questions.
5. Contact SSC security at: <https://www.starkstate.edu/about/security/background-check-information/> to schedule your own BCII and FBI background checks. You will receive an email of verification of eligibility through your Stark State email once the FBI/BCII results are available. **Once you receive your email of verification of eligibility, you will need to go back to the Security Office and ask them to print a copy of your FBI/BCII background checks to bring with you for your application review.**
 - a. Please direct all background questions to the security office.
 - b. If verification of eligibility is not complete prior to application a student may be conditionally accepted into the program with proof of documentation of payment for background check.
6. After application requirements are completed, contact the Program Coordinator to schedule an appointment for your application to be reviewed. **Please bring the completed application and copies of your FBI/BCII background checks with you to your appointment.**
