Applying for financial aid

To help you pay for college using federal aid such as grants, work study and loans, you are required to file the **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** every year. *The Stark State College school code is 011141.*

Preparing to fill out the FAFSA

The FAFSA process is quicker and easier when you have a username and password called an FSA ID. If your parent is providing information on your FAFSA, he or she will need his or her own FSA ID as well. Learn more about the FSA ID and how to create yours at studentaid.gov/fsaid.

Gather information; the FAFSA asks questions about you and your finances, so have all your applicable information handy, including

- Social Security number
- alien registration number (if applicable)
- federal tax information and tax returns
- records of untaxed income (if applicable)
- cash, savings and checking account balances
- investments other than the home in which you live.

Filling out the FAFSA

Each October, the FAFSA is available for the next school year. It is important to fill it out every year as soon as possible to meet deadlines. **You can complete and submit the FAFSA electronically at studentaid.gov.**

FAFSA follow-up

After you submit your FAFSA, the results will be sent to Stark State College within 7-10 business days.

You will receive an email from the US Dept. of Education within a few days letting you know your FAFSA was processed.	Stark State College may request additional information via your Stark State email account. Please respond promptly.	After review, we will send you an email that your award package is ready for your review via mySSC.

Check your email regularly to avoid missing financial updates and being held responsible for your account balance.

Using myBill+Payment

Your statement balance is available **only online** via mySSC; it will not be mailed to you. Select a payment option using **myBill+Payment** via **mySSC**.

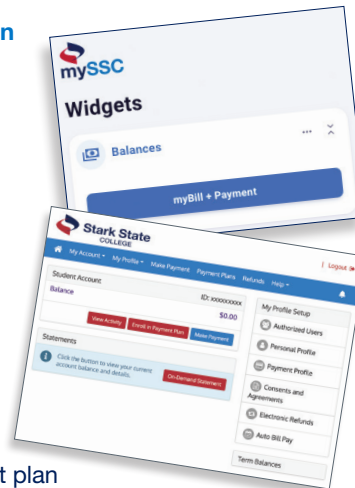
My Profile

Refunds

If your account has an overpayment or you're expecting a financial aid refund, you have two options and will need to select one in My Profile:

1. direct deposit to your bank/savings account
2. mailed check; verify your current mailing address in My Profile

PAY IN FULL

Payment of tuition and fees may be made in full

- online using **myBill+Payment** via **mySSC**
- at the cashier's window, S300 (main campus)
- deposited in the payment drop box on the third floor of the Student Services Building
- at SSC Akron at the College Store
- by mail: Bursar's Office, 6200 Frank Ave. NW, N. Canton, OH 44720.

Fees may be paid with cash, check, money order, debit card or Visa/MasterCard/Discover card. There will be a 3.5 % processing fee on credit card transactions.

Do not send cash in the mail or drop box. If you are paying by mail, enclose the statement with your payment. The most accurate way to view your current tuition and fees is online via myBill+Payment.

PAYMENT PLAN

You have the option of a payment plan that allows you to pay your tuition and fees in installments. A \$25 fee per semester is assessed, but no interest is charged.

Go to **myBill+Payment** via **mySSC** to set up your payment plan.
